The blood that remains in your baby's umbilical cord after it has been cut is called cord blood and is rich in stem cells. Stem cells are one of the most promising areas of medical treatment for a number of common illnesses because they are the body's "master" cells and regenerate into the cells that form all other tissues, organs, and systems in the body. Stem cells have the power to heal and are currently being used to treat over 75 life-threatening illnesses. Cord blood can be collected at birth and banked for potential future use.
